Angaston Medical Centre underwent a refurbishment of their Murray Street clinic in 2020 and sought to create a waiting room space that was inviting, interesting and had links with the community. In addition to having a mural by renowned local photographer Guy Draper, Angaston Medical Centre is proud to partner with Foundation Barossa and Tutti Arts Barossa to create a 'Waiting Room Art Gallery'.

Tutti Arts is one of Australia's leading disability arts companies where artists with a learning disability are creating new artworks for a growing local and international audience. Tutti Arts has been operating visual arts and film & new media programs in the Barossa since September 2017 with ongoing support from the Barossa Council and has most recently exhibited at the Lyell McEwin Hospital, Centre for Creative Health Art Gallery.

The AMC Waiting Room Art Gallery provides patients with an opportunity to view Tutti Arts Barossa artworks while they are waiting for their appointment and the ability to purchase and support these artists.

A percentage of the sale of the art will support Foundation Barossa in encouraging philanthropy and providing a vehicle through which the community can help the community.
